

Extracting Web Images

The *Extract from Web* feature on the Image Viewer allows you to view and download images directly from the Web. You can use this feature to download a single image from a website, or download all images from a single website.

Extracting Single Images

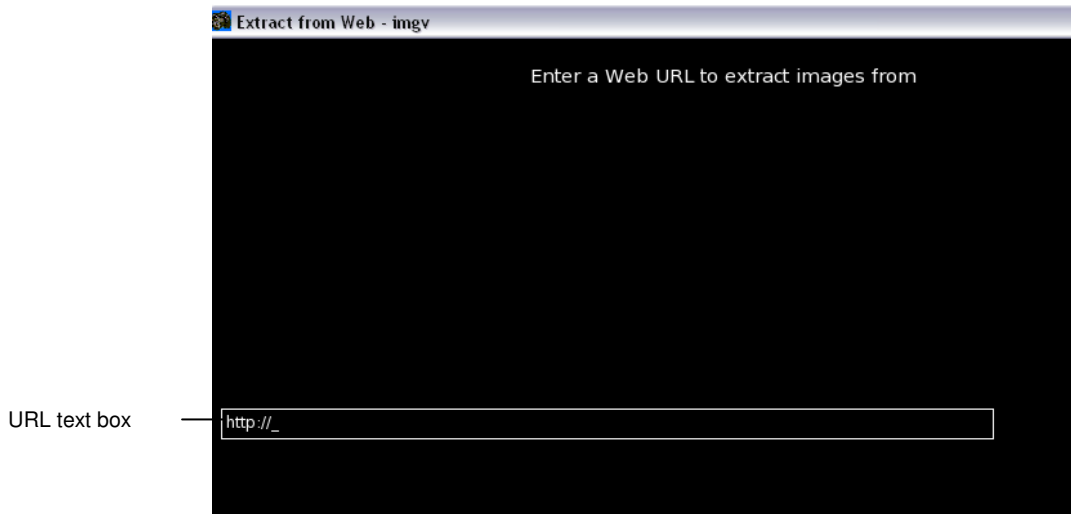
1. On the *Main* window, click **Extract from Web**.

Figure 1: Main Window



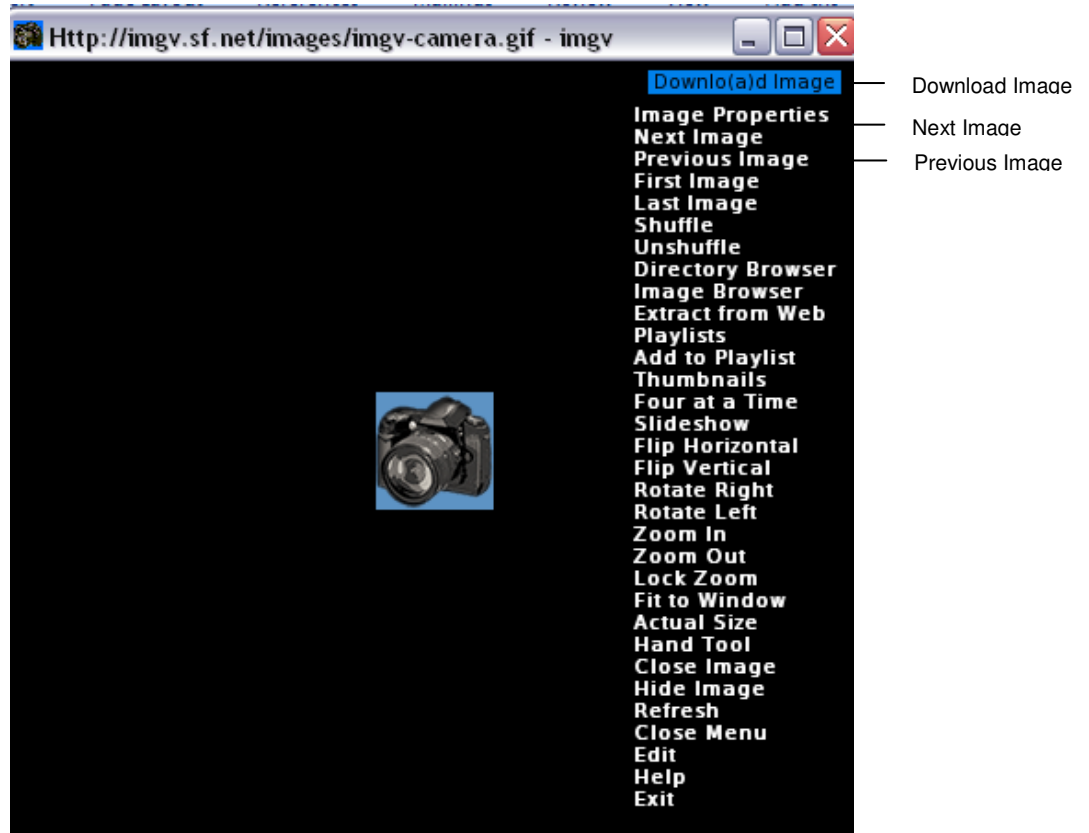
The *Extract from Web* – *imgv* window appears.

Figure 2: Extract from Web-imgv Window



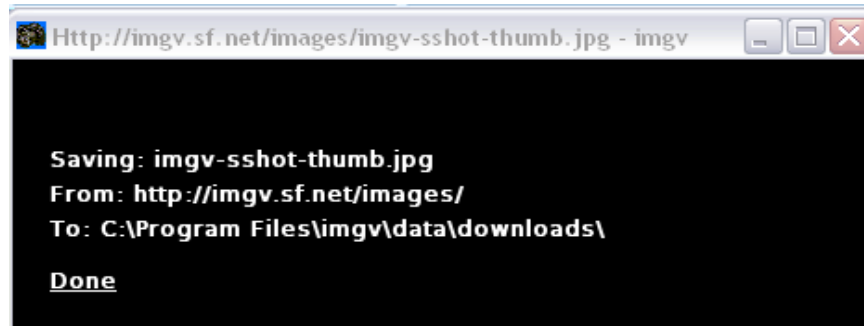
2. In the *URL* text box, type the URL of the image that you want to view.
3. Press **ENTER**. The selected image will appear on the center of the Image Viewer.

4. Click **Download Image** or type **A**. A confirmation window will appear and inform you that your selected image will be saved to *C:\Program Files\imgv\data\downloads*.
5. Click **Done** to exit this screen.

Extracting Multiple Images

1. On the *Main* window, click **Extract from Web**. (see *Figure 1: Main Window* on page 1). The *Extract from Web – imgv* window appears (see *Figure 2: Extract from Web-imgv Window* on page 2).
2. In the *URL* text box, type the URL of the Web page that contains the images that you want to view.
3. Press **ENTER**. All of the images from that website will be loaded onto the Image Viewer (see *Figure 3: Selected Image* on page 2).
4. Click **Next Image** or **Previous Image** to scroll through the list of images from the selected website.
5. For each image that you want to extract, click **Download Image** or type **A**. A confirmation window will appear and inform you that your selected image will be saved to *C:\Program Files\imgv\data\downloads*.
6. Click **Done** to exit this screen.
